School Bus Transportation 2012/13 School Year

- Current ridership increased by 284 students or approx. 11% this school year
- 74% of all students ride Licking Heights buses



School Bus Transportation 2012/13 School Year continued...

- Percentage of students riding buses:
 - ❖ 58% at LH High School
 - ❖ 80% at Central Middle School
 - ❖ 86% at North & South Elementaries
 - ❖ 70% at West Elementary



If the operating levy passes...

- No reductions to current bus service
- Additional routes will be added to relieve current bus schedule challenges
- Continue to provide busing for educational field trips



If the levy fails...

- High school busing will be eliminated as of December 3, 2012
- 18 a.m. and 18 p.m. routes will be eliminated
- Bus driver layoffs



If the levy fails, continued...

- Licking Heights field trips will be eliminated for all grade levels
- Private/Nonpublic high school busing also eliminated by December 3, 2012 for: Newark Catholic, Gahanna Christian and Liberty Christian East
