RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO PROCEED WITH ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION (R.C. 5705.21 and 5705.03)

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2009, the Board passed a resolution declaring the necessity, for the purpose of general permanent improvements, to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation in the amount of one and ninety nine hundredths (1.99) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to nineteen and nine

tenths (\$0.199) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time; and

WHEREAS, the Licking County Auditor has certified to the Board that the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax levy during the first year of collection is \$1,033,630, based on the current tax valuation of the School District of \$519,411,590;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Licking Heights Local School District, Licking and Franklin Counties, Ohio, two-thirds of all of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Board desires to proceed with the submission of the question of the tax levy to the electors of the School District.

<u>Section 2</u>. The question of such tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the School District at the election to be held therein on November 3, 2009 (the "Election Date").

Section 3. The form of the ballot to be used at said election shall be as follows:

An additional tax for the benefit of the Licking Heights Local School District, Licking and Franklin Counties, Ohio for the purpose of **general permanent improvements**, at a rate not exceeding one and ninety nine hundredths (1.99) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to nineteen and nine tenths (\$0.199) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

FOR THE TAX LEVY
AGAINST THE TAX LEVY

<u>Section 4</u>. The Treasurer of the Board is hereby directed and shall certify, not later than August 20, 2009 (which date is not less than 75 days prior to the Election Date), to the Licking County Board of Elections a copy of the resolution of July 29, 2009 and a copy of this resolution together with the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax levy during the first year of collection, based on the current tax valuation of the School District, as estimated by the Licking County Auditor.

<u>Section 5</u>. The Treasurer of the Board is hereby directed and shall simultaneously certify to the Licking County Board of Elections, that the levy will be for general permanent improvements for a continuing period of time and that such levy will include a levy on the 2009 tax list and duplicate (2010 collection year), if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

<u>Section 6</u>. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
