**All prices are based on YMCA membership. If you are a not a YMCA member then there is a different rate.**

**YMCA Full Time:** YMCA program Monday-Friday 7:00 AM-5:30 PM. This is a year round program and operates during school breaks.

**YMCA Full Time with LH half day PS (wrap around care)**- Program operates Monday-Friday 7:00 AM-5:30 PM. Child must be enrolled into the LH preschool thru the school district if you choose this option. The cost includes both the LH half day fee and the YMCA fee. The child spends 2.5 hours in a LH classroom on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, full day spent in YMCA class on Wednesdays.

**YMCA Full Time with LH half day PS 4 days a week (wrap around care)**-Program operates M-TH No care on Fridays 7:00 AM-5:30 PM. Child must be enrolled into the LH preschool thru the school district if you choose this option. The cost includes both the LH half day fee and the YMCA fee. The child spends 2.5 hours in a LH classroom.

**YMCA 4 day Part time (AM only)**-Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Fridays 8:15 am-11:00 AM. YMCA class only

### Registration:

If you are interested in participating in the YMCA preschool program at Licking Heights Central, please follow these steps:

1. Contact our Child Care office at 740-927-3365 ext 30256 or email [carrie.rocco@bvfyymca.org](mailto:carrie.rocco@bvfyymca.org)
2. Complete all registration documents prior to registration appointment (forms will be emailed to you)
3. Submit a \$35.00 non-refundable/transferable registration fee
4. If you would like your child to be a YMCA youth member for \$12.00 a month or a to obtain a Family membership please let Carrie Rocco know and she can set this up for you. This will then allow you to receive the YMCA member rate for the weekly fees.

### Tuition:

\*Tuition is due every Monday and is considered late by end of business day Tuesday.

\*A \$15.00 late payment fee will be applied to student account if tuition is not received by end of business day Tuesday. We have online payment and automatic bank draft options.

### Financial Assistance:

\*Financial assistance is available through the Job and Family Service and the YMCA. If you are an approved PFCC participant or scholarship participant, you will need to provide proof of services prior to enrollment.

### **Participant Eligibility:**

- Typical Students 3yrs-5 yrs of age
- If your child is on an IEP for LH Preschool an observation is required prior to enrollment with the YMCA program.
- Fully potty trained (no pull-ups or diapers)

### **Curriculum:**

The YMCA will implement Creative curriculum. The Creative Curriculum is a comprehensive curriculum that covers all domains of early learning. The content of each unit is built around a carefully crafted daily routine within an activity-center day. Themes, skills and concepts are developed through center focused play and learning.

### **Program Assessments:**

Each student participating in the YMCA preschool program will complete the Ages and Stages (ASQ) student questionnaire. This is an initial student/parent questionnaire to assess where a student is at developmentally and used as a guide to develop student goals. Throughout the school year, teachers will utilize the Early Learning Assessment tool to aid teachers in determining where children are in their readiness for kindergarten. We will meet with parents twice a year for conferences.

### **Sample Daily Schedule:**

\*If your child goes to the AM LH program they will leave our YMCA class from 9:00-11:45 AM and if your child goes to the PM LH program they will leave our class from 12:15-3:00 PM

7:00-8:00 Centers, Art & Crafts, Free play  
8:00-8:30 Breakfast (Provided by the school)  
8:30-9:00 Small Groups  
9:00-9:15 Morning Meeting  
9:15-10:15 Circle time and Curriculum  
10:15-10:45 Gross Motor or Outside Play (use of indoor gym when needed)  
10:45- 11:30 Learning Centers  
11:30- 12:15 Lunch (provided by the school)  
12:15- 12:45 Indoor gross motor or story time  
12:45-1:00 PM Prepare for nap/yoga/calm down time  
1:00-3:00 Nap time  
3:00-3:30 Restrooms/snack time (snack provided by YMCA)  
3:30-4:00 Afternoon meeting/learning centers  
4:00-4:30 Gross Motor or Outside Play (use of indoor gym when needed)  
4:30-5:00 Art or Free choice  
5:00-5:30 Program wrap up and clean up

**Meals & Snacks:** The school district will provide lunch. No outside food is permitted for breakfast or lunch unless the child has a note from a physician that they are to pack a lunch. The YMCA will provide an afternoon snack.

### **What to Bring to school:**

- \*Small backpack and water bottle
- \*Change of clothes (including shoes)
- \*Nap time items (small blanket, pillow, comfort item)
- \*Take home folder (teacher provided)
