



All students who utilize Licking Heights Transportation must follow rules established by the State of Ohio and the Licking Heights Transportation Department. Any misbehavior that distracts the driver is a <u>very serious hazard</u> that jeopardizes the safety of all passengers.

*Be at your assigned stop at least 5 minutes before your pick-up time and wait in your designated place of safety until the bus arrives.

*Go directly to your assigned seat and remain seated for the entire bus ride, keeping your body and belongings out of the aisle.

*Keep your backpack closed and on your lap. Do not throw or pass items.

*Speak quietly and do not use profane language or obscene gestures.

*Do not eat or drink on the bus.

*Do not bring alcohol, tobacco, drugs or drug paraphernalia, animals, live insects, glass objects, weapons, or instruments of violence onto the bus.

*Be absolutely quiet at railroad tracks, or whenever your driver or aide asks you to be quiet.



*Do not hang body parts or items out the window. Do not throw anything out the window.

*Keep your body to yourself. Do not horseplay or fight.

*Electronic devices may be used on the bus if in compliance to the conditions listed:

*Electronic devices may be used by students while riding the school bus providing they do not compromise bus safety, become a distraction to others, or violate the bus/school student code of conduct.t **Possession and use of an electronic device is a privilege that may be forfeited by any student who violates bus or school rules relative to the unauthorized use of electronic devices.** Devices CAN BE confiscated for inappropriate use and will be forwarded to the Principal or Dean of Students of the appropriate building. NO TAKING VIDEOS OR PICTURES ON THE BUS. NO PLAYING VIDEOS, GAMES AND MUSIC OUT LOUD.





BE READY FOR YOUR SCHOOL BUS!



Your child **must** be dressed, backpack on and ready when our bus arrives.

Please be at your <u>designated stop</u> 5 minutes before your bus arrives. Delays cause us to be late for the next student.



Being available for your Kindergarten student



Please note that we must see a parent or designated adult, in order to release your <u>kindergarten student</u> at the end of their day. Please be ready at least 5 minutes before your designated drop off time. If the bus is going to be late, you will receive a call from the transportation department.

What's your name?

Make sure that your student's belongings are marked, so that their driver can ID them at the beginning of the year.

They will get an ID card that has to be attached to their book bags once they have school pictures made.



<u>How to properly cross the road in front of the bus.</u>



When you exit the bus, walk 10 giant steps forward. Stop. Look at your driver. She or he will have their hand up. When they lower their hand, walk to the edge of the bus and look both ways before crossing to your driveway or parent.

NEVER cross behind the bus.

If you drop something near the bus, do not try to pick it up. Tell your bus driver instead.

Keeping our students safe!

Your student(s) needs to stay seated, and talk quietly. They are not permitted to get out of their seats and walk around while the bus is moving. They need to keep their hands to themselves. *Please review the rules with them.*



No eating on the bus!

Not only is it a choking hazard, it also makes a huge mess on our buses. Make sure that your student knows this rule.


