Procedures for Obtaining a CDL Learner's Permit

To get a CDL or CDL learner's permit (CLP) you are required to be at least 18 years of age and have a valid Ohio driver's license.

Bring the following to the licensing office:

- Your social security card issued by the Social Security Administration. Your social security number is required for identification purposes. This is a mandatory requirement.
- Your valid automobile or classified driver's license.

CLP Tests:

Inform the testing facility that you need to obtain a CDL Class B learner's permit with School Bus (S) and Passenger (P) endorsements. The written test is four parts: General Knowledge, Air Brakes, School Bus, and Passenger. You may take all four parts in one sitting, or make multiple visits to complete the tests.

Once you obtain your CLP, it is valid for six months. A CLP expires after six months and cannot be renewed. A new permit must be purchased and the vision and knowledge tests must be re-taken.

The CLP fee is \$27.00
