<u>Classwork/Participation</u>

Classwork and participation points will come from stations, worksheets completed in class, Daily Math Practice, and etc. Homework: 10%

<u>Homework</u>

- Homework is posted on the board and students are responsible for writing the assignment down in their agendas and getting the homework done on time.
- Students will have homework on most nights Monday-Thursday.
- If you forget your book. Login to the online textbook and print homework pages to complete. If you do not have a printer, just write down the problems, work and answers on a separate sheet.
- Textbook homework is usually worth 4 points every night (2 points for completion and 2 points for accurate answer).
- Worksheets may be worth more.
- Check your agenda, or Progressbook for the homework assignments.
- Textbook homework is not accepted late because we go over the answers the day it is due.

Quizzes and Tests

Tests will be given at the end of every chapter, with quizzes given throughout. If you are not happy with your **test** grade, you have the option of completing a retake test. If you choose to complete a retake test, you may use any resource available to you (book, notes, computer, & family member). It will be due two school days after it was sent home. Your final score will be an average of the original test and retake test. If you do worse on the retake I will keep your original score.

Multiplication Facts

We will begin the year with daily timed multiplication tests. You will begin with twos and work your way up through twelves. After mastering all the facts, there will be an A, B, and C test with all the facts mixed. Students will have 2 minutes to complete 36 problems, and must achieve 100% accuracy to pass on the next test.
