### YMCA Before & After School Program

#### Program Locations:

**South Elementary**-in cafeteria at LH South, use main entrance for AM and PM care

**West Elementary**-children are bussed by the school district to LH South, use main entrance for AM and PM care

**North Elementary KG**-the AM program is at LH Central, use the back side preschool entrance for drop off in AM. For the PM program the kids are walked by a YMCA staff to LH South for PM care. Please use the main entrance at LH South for pick up.

**LH Central (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders)**-PM only program and the children are walked by YMCA staff to LH South for PM care. Please use main entrance for pick up.
