

## **Student Directory Information Release Option**

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), a federal law, limits the disclosure of personally identifiable information about your student's educational records without prior written consent. However, student directory information (name, address, or telephone number), may be released to outside organizations without prior parental consent.

Recognizing the challenges faced by military recruiters, the No Child Left Behind law requires high schools to provide to military recruiters, upon request, access to names, addresses, and telephone numbers of high school juniors and seniors.
