Dear Licking Heights High School Parents and Students,

Licking Heights Local Schools is committed to the safety and health of our students and staff. We are informing you we have recently received information that an individual from your child's school building has tested positive for COVID-19. We are working closely with our local health departments, and anyone identified as a close contact has already been notified as part of the COVID-19 investigation.

Cleaning and disinfecting of the exposed locations have been completed.

Licking Heights High School will remain OPEN at this time.

We ask you to take these steps to continue to be aware of your child's health:

- Continue to check your child for COVID-19 symptoms daily: fever or chills, new uncontrolled cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, new onset of severe headache, especially with fever.
- If anyone in your household develops symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19, they should immediately isolate and call your local health department, and/or your medical providers.
- If NO symptoms develop and you have not been instructed otherwise to quarantine your child for a different exposure, your child may continue to attend school.
