Dear Hornet Families:

The COVID-19 impact on our school and community is rapidly changing; therefore, our action plan and response must evolve accordingly. Since teaching and learning has shifted from its typical form to a virtual one, the grading practices should also change. We believe that virtual learning should not have an adverse impact on student grades. Therefore, Licking Heights Local Schools will shift to meet expectations (P), progressing toward expectations (MP) and an incomplete (I) system for students in grades K - 4.

Interim Grades

Teachers will evaluate students as either meeting expectations (P), progressing toward expectations (MP), or an Incomplete (I). A “P” means the student has logged in and completed the required assignments in Google classroom. A “MP” means the student has logged into the computer but has not completed all required assignments. A student who receives an “I” has not logged in or completed any assignments. All interims will be mailed for students in grades K - 4.

Fourth Quarter Grades

Teachers will evaluate students as either meeting expectations (P), progressing toward expectations (MP). A student can receive an “I” for insufficient evidence of learning or evidence that does not meet the criteria at the “MP” or “P” level, due to a medical issue or other extenuating circumstance. An “N” will also be added for students who have insufficient evidence of learning and do not meet the criteria for an “I.” All fourth quarter report cards will be mailed for students in grades K - 4.
