
In Ohio:

- If a school bus is stopped on a street or road which has fewer than four lanes, all traffic approaching the bus from EITHER direction must stop at least 10 feet from the front and rear of the bus and remain stopped until the bus moves or the bus driver signals motorists to proceed.
- If the bus is stopped on a street or road which has four or more lanes, ONLY traffic proceeding in the same direction as the bus must stop. (Source: Digest of Ohio Motor Vehicle Laws)



If the bus is stopped on a street with four or more lanes, only traffic proceeding in the same direction as the bust must stop.
